Sub: Admission in Under Graduate and Post graduate Courses in ASU&H College for academic session 2020-21-reg.

Sir/Madam,

I am directed to refer to the subject cited above and to say that the Ministry has received various representations requesting to reduce the required percentile criteria in the AIAPGET-2020 in order to be eligible for admission in Ayurveda, Siddha, Unani and Homoeopathy (ASU & H) PG courses for academic year 2020-21, due to various reasons.

2. In this regard, the matter has been examined by the Ministry and decided that in order to be eligible for admission in ASU & H PG courses for academic year 2020-21, it shall be necessary for a candidate to obtain minimum marks at  $40^{th}$  percentile in AIAPGET-2020.

However, in respect of candidates belonging to the Schedule Castes, the Scheduled Tribes, Other Backward Classes, the minimum marks shall be at 30<sup>th</sup> percentile. In respect of candidates with benchmark disabilities specified under the Rights of Persons with Disabilities Act, 2016, the minimum marks shall be at 35<sup>th</sup> percentile for Un-Reserved (UR) Category and 30<sup>th</sup> percentile for SC/ST/OBC.

- 3. Further, Ministry has decided to extend the last date/ cut-off date for admission in ASU & H Under-Graduation and Post-Graduate Courses upto 31<sup>st</sup> March, 2021 for academic year 2020-21.
- 4. This clarification is applicable only for academic year 2020-21.
- 5. This issues with the approval of the competent authority.
