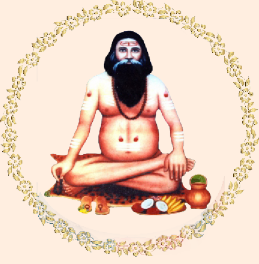
## Vision

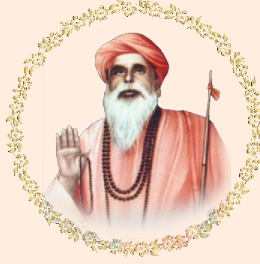

# Admission Criteria

## B A M S COURSE

### ELIGIBILITY FOR ADMISSION

1. The candidates should have passed the two years P.U.C examination conducted by the P.U Education Board, Karnataka State, with Physics, Chemistry & Biology as optional subjects; or any other examination recognized as equivalent to it by the Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences, Bangalore. OR The candidates should have passed the B.Sc examination from recognized statutory University provided he/she has passed the B.Sc examination with not less than three of the following subjects: Physics, Chemistry, Botany, Zoology.
2. The Candidates should have secured not less than 50% of the total marks in Science subjects taken altogether at the qualifying examination. However the OBC-3A category and SC/ST students of Karnataka are required to secure 40% of the total marks.
3. The Candidate should have completed seventeen years of age as on 31st December of the year of admission.
4. Foreign students desiring admission should produce: (a) A No Objection Certificate from the Department of Health & Family Welfare, Government of India, New Delhi. (b) An eligibility Certificate from the Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences, Bangalore. (c) Student Visa. (d) Residential Certificate.
5. The Selection is based on the National Eligibility cum Entrance Test (National Eligibility cum Entrance Test), conducted once a year by the Indian Government seeking admission into the course.
6. Among the total number of seats available i.e. 100 15% (15seats) will be filled by the National Eligibility cum Entrance Test (NEET) results for the domicile of Indian citizen only. 25% (25 seats) will be filled by the examination results for the domicile of Karnataka only. Of the remaining 20% (20 seats) will be for the N.R.I students and others and 40% (40 seats) will be for institutional preference.
7. The candidate shall have passed PUC, HSC or Intermediate examination from any recognised Board with Physics, Chemistry, Biology and have obtained minimum of fifty per cent. marks taken together in Physics, Chemistry and Biology in the case of general category and forty per cent. marks in the case of the Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes and Other Backward Classes
8. The candidates shall have passed 10+2 (or equivalent) with subjects of Physics, Chemistry, Biology or B.Sc in Biotechnology only". The admission shall continue to be done through National Eligibility-cum-Entrance Test (NEET) only.

Note: A minimum 80% attendance in theory and practical separately in each subject is required to be eligible for appearing examinations at the end of academic year subject to the condition that his/her progress and conduct are counted to be satisfactory by the Principal.
